

Jacob and Esau (part 1) Genesis 25:19-28

The Facts:

Fraternal twins born of Isaac and Rebekah Struggle between them started before birth Rebekah asked the Lord for an explanation of the struggle

Both will father a nation
One will be stronger than the other
The older will serve the younger

Named

Esau – because he was red Jacob - grabbed the heal, "trickster" or "supplanter"

Characteristics

Esau – outdoorsman Jacob – dweller in tents

The Problems

How could the older serve the younger? How could God choose one above the other?

Lessons for Us

Know that God works according to His will

He can use the least likely, least popular, most misunderstood (*Think* – Saul & David, *Think* John the Baptist, *Think* Jesus of Nazareth) We don't have to fully understand His will to know His will

Accept the will of God

For self

- accept your assets and liabilities
- accept your place in family, society & church

For others

accept that God can use others who are different than you

For life

• accept that God can work in different ways for different people

Before God

- Find peace in God's perfect character
- Cooperate with God's will for you
- Don't pretend to be the sole authority on God's will
