Read: [Genesis 24:21](#)

Rebekah's actions indicate God's leading in her life as well. Can you recall a time when God led you and your spouse to the same conclusion but independently of each other?

Did this offer confirmation of His leading in your life?

Read: *Genesis 24:32-38, 50-59*

How would you describe Rebekah's and her family's faith?

If faith does not result in action is it really faith? *See James 2:20*

Can you think of one action you can take or take as a couple that will help you align with God's plan for leading you?
