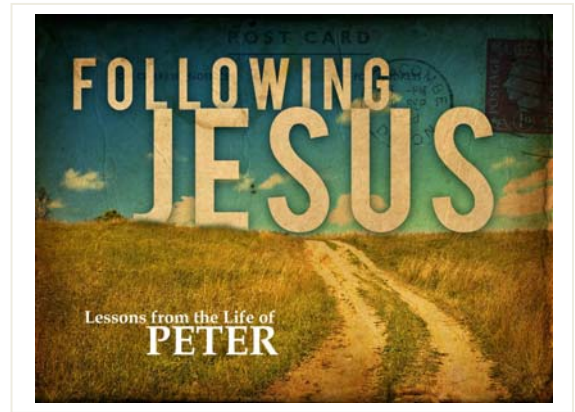


**Discussion guide for:

Opening up

Thinking about the most influential teacher you have had, identify what qualities allowed them to make an impact on your life?

Observing the scriptures

As you read Luke 5:1-11 note the methods Jesus used to communicate life to the disciples.

1. Direction (vs. 1-3) "I will tell you what to do"
2. Instruction (vs. 3-4) "I will tell you why to do it"
3. Conversation (vs. 5) "We can discuss what to do"
4. Demonstration (vs. 6-9) "I will show you what is to be done"
5. Anticipation (vs. 10) "I will tell you what you can do"
6. Invitation (vs. 11) "You have permission to do"

Which of the above do you think is the most overused and to what result?

Which do think is the most underused and to what result?

How to react to the concept that the family is a disciple-making unit?

What practical step can you take to either find someone to follow or allow someone to follow you as you follow Jesus?

Spend some time praying individually or as a group about employing the methods of the disciple-maker.
