

# Unshared Glory (Judges 7:1-8)

## Main Idea

God's glory is not to be shared so let's make sure that we don't steal victory & credit due to Him who is deserving of our praise.

### Ice Breaker:

Recall a time when you "won" or were victorious despite the "odds" that were against you.

# **Application**

Learn to trust God even when His methods for our obedience seems strange God uses our failures & limitations for His glory

### **Bottom Line**

Like Gideon let us recognize the danger of fighting in our own strength (stealing God's glory). Know that we have victory in our battles when we give God the glory & not ourselves!
