What do you think of when you read the words "go" and "make" in Matthew 28:19:20?

How is Jesus with us today?

Thinking of all the relationships in your life; how do you fulfill the Great Commission in each of these?

Based on Mark 3:14, what does it mean to you to be "with him" and to be "sent out" by him?
