Mistake: Have a Stubborn Opinion

1. The care and feeding of a stubborn opinion

- Believe what you have always been told
- Think like you have always thought
- Do what you have always done
- Act like you always know best

Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, But fools despise wisdom and instruction

2. Down the road with a stubborn opinion

- You miss God's voice from an unlikely source
- You miss God's direction at an unusual time
- You miss God's blessing
- You will hurt others along the way.

Proverbs 14:12 There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death

3. How to overcome a stubborn opinion

(And yes, you have them! And so do !!)

- Know the question to always ask.
- Know clearly what is clearly revealed by God!
- Know that God leads you to the truth in amazing ways.
- Know that the ultimate outcome is good
- Know that others will challenge you commitment to God
