There are several places in the Scriptures where "Living Water" is mentioned. Below are a few of these references. Take some time alone or with others to read these passages and then use the questions for meditation and discussion:

Read: Isaiah 44:3

Questions: What do the images of a thirsty land and dry ground communicate to you? How does the Spirit bring refreshment into your life?

Read: Jeremiah 2:13

Questions: What is the result of abandoning the living water? Where in your life has self-effort led to "broken cistern" experiences?

Read: John 3:5

Questions: How did Jesus describe the essential role of the Spirit in salvation? In what ways did God "work behind the scenes" to bring you to Himself?

Read: John 4:14

Questions: How does Jesus contrast natural water with living water; what does He wish to express with this comparison? How does this encourage you?

Read: Revelation 22:1-2

Questions: Why do you think the Water of Life flows through the main street of heaven? How does the concept of a neverending supply of "living water" encourage you?
