Main Idea

4. Read Luke 2:46–47: How have you benefitted from being in cooperate worship?

5. Read Luke 2:52: Define wisdom. Why is greater Bible knowledge not the same as wisdom? What's the danger in thinking they are the same things?

6. Read Luke 2:49

- Notice that Jesus was about His Father's business (doing the will of God). Where do you find it most difficult to walk in obedience to God when it causes offense to others?
- Has your passion for The LORD ever been misunderstood by your family or friends? If so, please explain.
- Where do you need help in doing God's will?

- 2. Be among people who know God
- 3. Be in a conversation about God
- 4. Be astonished of the presence of God
- 5. Be accepting of the mission of God
