Acts 2:42 "And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers."

Translated as:

fellowship 12 times communion 4 times communication 1 time

Definition:

Strong's:

- 1) fellowship, association, community, communion, joint participation,
 - 1a) the share which one has in anything, participation
 - 1b) fellowship, intimacy
 - 1b1) the right hand as a sign and pledge of fellowship (in fulfilling the apostolic office)
 - 1c) a gift jointly contributed, a collection, a contribution,
 - as exhibiting an embodiment and proof of fellowship

Waggoner's:

"To share that which one has in common for the purpose of mutual edification"

Application:
