Main Idea

A crisis can reveal a Christ-follower

1. What kind of dreams disturb you?

Discussion Questions

1. What were your thoughts about this chapter? Did you have any take-aways, challenges, or truths that spoke to you? Explain...
2. How does Daniel respond to King Nebuchadnezzar's decree of the execution of all the wise men (V. 12-16)?
How do you respond in crisis?
3. As Daniel embraces the crisis at hand of interpreting King Nebuchadnezzar's dream; what role is played by Daniel's personal faith in God? God's revelation? Group prayer?
4. Thinking of the crisis & the demands that came upon King Nebuchadnezzar's staff to interrupt his dream; what drives you crazy in a crisis or with demands?
How do you decide when to just give up & when to say no?
5. Looking at verses 20-23; how may your prayer life imitate Daniel's praise & thanksgiving?

Application

Be careful not to make irrational decisions during an emotional situation
Know that God can even take our foolish choices & use them for His good (Rom. 8:28)
God's will is not blocked by human effort
