

Family Matters: Real Love Ephesians 5:25-32

**Main Idea:** Sacrifice, giving, making progress, valuing, and bonding for another are all characteristics of love that is defined by Jesus.

Connect: Growing up, what were you told about love? Were you given any advice on it?

## **Discuss**

- 1. What from this week's message have you applied to your current family situation?
- 2. Do you think that a person's loyalty and participation to both marriage and the local church need constant attention? Give reasons for your answer.
- 3. Think of how you feel after feeding your body the wrong food for several days in a row, and how much this changes when you care for your body properly. What does the comparison to food (v29) teach us about what a healthy relationship needs?
- 4. Does thinking about marriage in terms of Christ's love and sacrifice for the church change your perspective on commitment?
- 5. What is spiritually nourishing for a marriage? Is this unique to each marriage, or are there principals that apply to all marriage?
- 6. How can knowing and understanding God's design for marriage help you when difficulties arise in your relationships?
