Main Idea

Discussion Questions

1. In your own words explain the main point of Hannah's prayer in verses 3-10
2. Describe the practices of Eli's sons regarding taking meat from the Israelites (V. 12-17).
3. What other sin did Eli's sons commit? (Think: Consider how religious perversion was associated with moral perversion)? What can you learn?
4. What did Eli do about his sons' sins?
How did his sons respond? (Think: How did this affect the other Israelites?)
5. Share what it means to be a "Hannah" parent & an "Eli" parent
6. Share one of the best things your parents did in raising you
7. What is one challenge you face as being a godly role model?
8. What is the most important thing you can do to raise your child upright?

Application-Life Principles

1. When you respect God (vs. 2)
Respect flows from appreciation of His holiness (vs.2)
Respect results in blessing and growth (v.18-21, 26)
Frequently remind yourself that God is Holy
2. When you disrespect God (vs. 3)
Disrespect flows from pride and arrogance (vs. 3)
Disrespect affects worship, obedience & relationships (vs. 12-17, 22)
Disrespect results in disaster (vs. 17, 25)
Frequently remind yourself to remain humble
