



Unleashed: You Have Found a Home (Acts 4:23-31)

Main Idea: God wants you to fully engage in your spiritual home.

Connect: When you think of being home, what is the first thing that comes to mind?

Discuss

1. What insight, observation, or principal from this sermon did you find to be most helpful, insightful or troubling? Explain ...
2. Peter and John returned to their “small group” of believers and they all prayed together. What do you think the benefit is of praying together as a group? Do you enjoy praying aloud in a group? Why or why not?
3. What makes God’s house a home? Does your physical home share any traits with your spiritual home?
4. Imagine the political and religious environment that the believers were experiencing. The prayer recorded for us includes a rich Old Testament explanation of what they were living through. How do you use scripture to support you as you live your life? Does this change when times are good versus when they are tough?
5. Recount a time when you realized God’s work in your life or in the life of another. What clued you in that it was God’s work? How did you recognize Him?
6. Acts 4:31 “And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.” What does it look like for a believer to be bold through the power of the Holy Spirit? Have you ever been emboldened by the power of the Holy Spirit?
7. Prayer should be the hallmark of a relationship with Christ. Turn to your neighbor, ask them how you can pray for them, join hands, and pray.

Live it Out
